

ZCSD offers tree, bench program

The Zachary Community School District has unveiled a Memorial Tree and Bench program. Perfect for gift-giving, the new program provides a way to honor a loved one, celebrate a special event, or honor an individual or organization that has made a difference in the community.

Donors may choose the option of purchasing a tree or a bench to be placed at any of the ZCSD sites. Various types of trees are available including bald cypress, red oak, crape myrtle and magnolia. The cost to purchase any of these trees is \$400. The cost to purchase a live oak is \$600, and donors who select a live oak will have the option of purchasing an approved monument sign to be located near the tree for an additional cost. Trees will be purchased and placed according to the landscape plan at the school site. They will be planted in the ideal planting season.

The price range for a bench is \$800 to \$1200. Price includes installation of bench and engraved name plate on memorial plaque at school site. Bench style and placement will be determined by the ZCSD based on current need. Benches will be placed on the school site of donor's preference.

Sheriff substation welcomed

The East Baton Rouge Parish Sheriff's Office opened the second of two new substations in the northern part of the parish last month when community members, leaders and personnel from EBRSO, the East Baton Rouge Parish School System and ExxonMobil recently gathered for a grand opening ceremony.

The Pride/Chaneyville substation, a 5,000-sq. ft. facility located at 12828 Jackson Road, is the site of the old Chaneyville High School. The \$200,000 substation was made possible by land donated from EBRP Schools and four parts of a 12-section modular building contributed by ExxonMobil.

Sheriff Sid Gautreaux said the substation will be manned 24-hours a day under the command of Captain Richard Harris, and the 16 deputies employed there will rotate in four shifts.

The 10-acre facility will also house a radio operator and secretary, EBR School Crossing Guards, Field Training Officers program, a Bomb Squad and Reserves Division. The Cpl. Danny P. Harris Memorial Track was also unveiled at the grand opening and is named after Harris's late brother, a

former EBRSO deputy. The walking track is the property of the EBRPSS and is intended for area residents to utilize for exercise purposes.

The other eight sections of the building donated by ExxonMobil were used to construct the 10,000-sq.ft. Zachary/Plains substation located at 23060 Brian Road. That facility opened February 2011 and was made possible by land donated by the City of Zachary.
