

## Paramount earns accreditation

Accreditation by the ICANL means Paramount has undergone a thorough review of its operational and technical components by a panel of experts. ICANL grants accreditation only to facilities that are found to be providing quality patient care in compliance with national standards through a comprehensive application process including detailed case study review.

ICANL accreditation is a “seal of approval” that patients can rely on as an indication that a facility has been carefully critiqued on all aspects of its operations considered relevant by medical experts in nuclear medicine.
